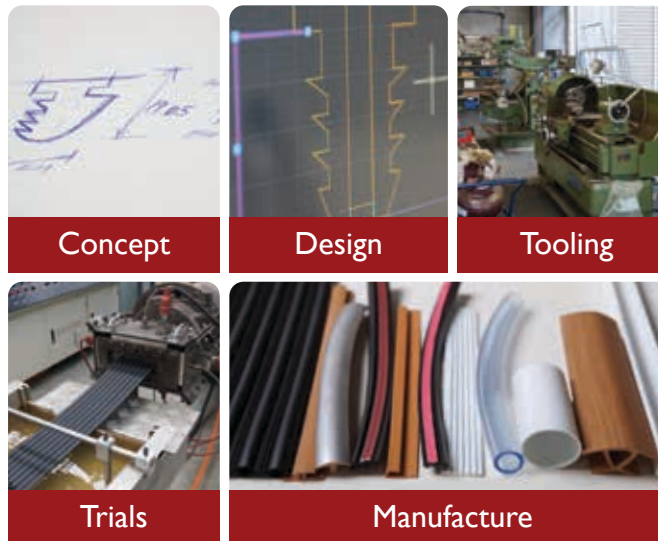


Procom Plastics operate from a modern purpose built, 4000m<sup>2</sup> manufacturing and warehouse facility in Campbellfield Victoria.

# Rigid Extrusions



We offer a diverse range of rigid materials including PVC, ASA, ABS Polypropylene and Polycarbonate.

Rigid PVC is the most commonly used and versatile of the materials and is extensively used in the construction industry.

ASA and Polycarbonate are examples of engineering plastics that display superior mechanical and/or thermal properties, having a combination of characteristics that can make it an ideal fit for a specific application.

To complete the package we offer inline printing, notching, punching, cutting to length and the application of adhesive tapes.

# Co-extrusions



The most common co-extrusions offer the combination of a rigid material for strength with a soft or flexible material for function.

A typical application is in the fabrication of the commercial aluminium windows where a thermoplastic rubber/polypropylene captive glazing wedge provides an economical superior seal with little or no shrinkage that will not roll out or disengage from the glazing pocket.



# Flexible Extrusions



We extrude a variety of flexible materials such as plasticised PVC, EVA, thermoplastic rubber and polyurethane.

Plasticised PVC is the most widely used of flexible extrusion materials and is extremely cost effective. It can be UV stabilised and is offered in a range of hardnesses and colours, including translucent and clear.

For the above reasons flexible PVC glazing gaskets and seals are traditionally used in the manufacture of aluminium windows.
